## Schedule

All games will have a 5-minute break. The schedules must be played exactly at the specified time, they will only have 5 minutes of extension for the team to be present inside the field with the minimum number of players to be able to start the games

All players, coaches, spectators, and officials, will participate in the spirit of FAIR PLAY and will conduct themselves in accordance with the tournament rules.

**Prices: 1<sup>st</sup> Place – Trophy and generic uniform for the whole team**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place Trophy and medals**

**Protests:** All protests must be made at the time that the illegality of the game is detected. and the referee must attest to it in the report, after the game is over, no protests are accepted.

**Player's Equipment:** Every player must wear the bracelet assigned to him at the time of registration together with his game identification ID, and show it to the referee to allow him to play.

**Conduct:** All coaches have total responsibility for the conduct of their players, bench, friends and spectators at all times. Coaching from the sidelines (giving direction to one's own team) is permitted provided:

- No mechanical devices are used;
- The tone of voice is instructive and not derogatory;
- Each coach or substitute remains within 10 yards of either side of the halfway line;
- No coach, substitute or spectator makes derogatory remarks or gestures to the referees, other coaches, players, substitutes or spectators;
- No coach, substitute or spectator uses profanity or incites, in any manner, disruptive behavior.

All participants must carry an identification at the time of registration and must use the ID's of Cal South or another organization as a credential for their games, if the player does not carry any ID with a photograph that player will not be allowed to play and will not be allowed to play. accept no excuse.

**Substitutions:** Unlimited substitutions are allowed in all age groups. Teams may substitute at any game stoppage of play with the referee's permission. Substitutes must wait on the sideline (off of the field of play) until the field player has left the field of play and/or the referee has indicated the substitute may enter the field of play. Substitutions will be made at the centerline.
